



CODE OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS

- Remember that children play organised sports for their own enjoyment. They are not there to entertain you
- Be on your best behaviour. Do not use profane language or harass, physically or verbally, players, managers, coaches, or Umpires
- Show respect for your team's opponents and applaud all good play by both teams
- Never ridicule or scold a child for making a mistake during game. Instead encourage, support and support them when perhaps things go slightly wrong!
- Condemn the use of verbal abuse
- Respect the match officials' decisions. Remember he/she is only human with the same feelings as you and, like you, sometimes makes an honest error
- Encourage players always to play according to the Laws of the Game, and the Spirit of the Game
- Read the Laws of the Game to better understand what you are looking at and commenting on
